Why become Professionally Registered?

Professional registration as an **Engineering Technician (EngTech)**, **Incorporated Engineer (IEng)** or **Chartered Engineer (CEng)** demonstrates internationally recognised levels of knowledge, competence and commitment through industry experience and training.

Registration is regulated by the **UK Engineering Council** and awarded through licensed Professional Engineering Institutions such as IAgrE.

For those working in environmental roles, IAgrE offers registration through the **Society for the Environment** as a **Chartered Environmentalist (CEnv)** and **Environmental Practitioner (REnvP)**.

Becoming professionally registered is a significant career milestone that you can be proud of.

What does it cost?

Membership starts from £45 per year. For those wishing to achieve the highest grade of membership and Chartered Registration, fees are from £250 per year.
